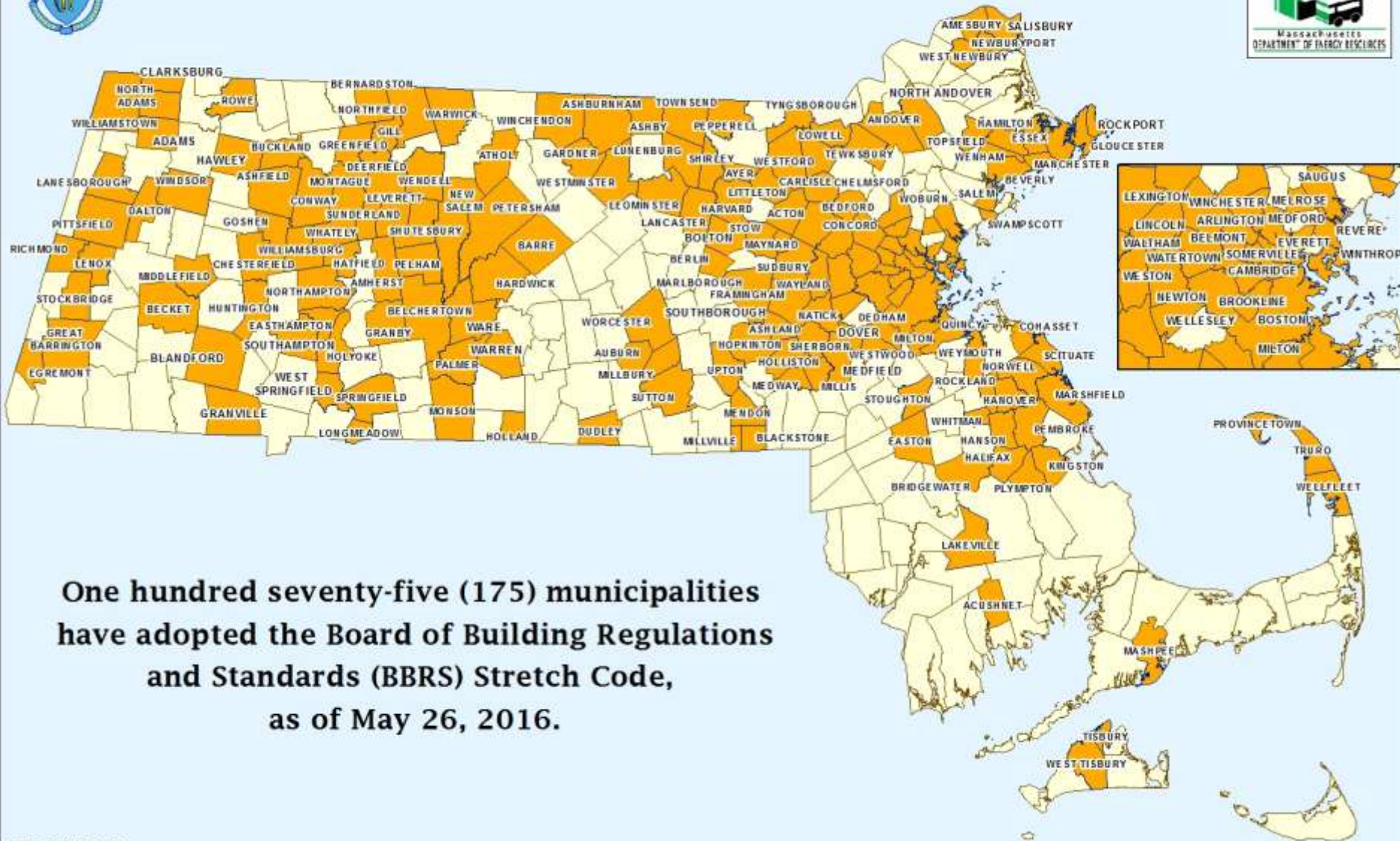

MA Energy Code: IECC in Statute

- MGL CH143 Section 94:
 - “To adopt and fully integrate **the latest International Energy Conservation Code** as part of the state building code, together with **any more stringent energy-efficiency provisions that the board, in consultation with the Department of Energy Resources, concludes are warranted.**”

Stretch code: 50% of MA communities

Stretch Code Adoption, by Community



One hundred seventy-five (175) municipalities have adopted the Board of Building Regulations and Standards (BBRS) Stretch Code, as of May 26, 2016.

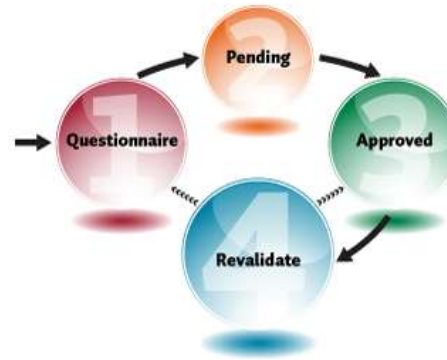

VOTER VALIDATION AREA SIMPLE FOUR STEP PROCESS

Welcome to ICC's new electronic voter eligibility verification system. Here you may designate your jurisdiction's Governmental Member Voting Representatives. You must complete an electronic questionnaire for every individual you'd like to designate to vote on your jurisdiction's behalf at this year's ABM and/or Final Action Hearings, even individuals who have voted on your behalf in the past. ICC will then either approve the individual or contact you for further information. And remember, you must submit the electronic questionnaire at least 30 days prior to the ABM and/or Final Action Hearings, as applicable. Get started below.
